Quartet was loosely based on Rhys' relationship with the modernist British author Ford Madox Ford, author of The Good Soldier, (which I reviewed here) and the Parade's End tetralogy. Ford was an early patron of Rhys and encouraged her writing. He chose Jean Rhys as her pen name. (Her real name was Ella Williams.)
